Précis of 100 Words or Less:	Despite major expenditures by governmental and international financial institutions for programs on judicial corruption and increases in the salaries of Russian judges, there appears to be no significant decrease in judicial corruption. This perspective is supported by Transparency International and most independent scholars, as opposed to institutionally sponsored works. Systemic (e.g. publishing judicial decisions) changes, political will and an evolution in societal attitudes are required before there will be significant improvements in this area. The Russian population probably needs to spend another 40 years in the desert.
