The research included studying the scale and scope of the development of computer crime in Saratov and the Saratov region, which led to the conclusion that this type of crime is transnational in nature and that computer crimes committed by an organized group are analogous to those committed by individual actors. On the basis of the materials gathered, the author has created a sociological profile of a computer criminal who works inside an organized crime group. The author has determined the efficacy of measures taken to curb organized cybercrime by law enforcement agencies and other government entities, both across the Russian Federation and in the Saratov region. The author puts forth recommendations for fighting organized computer crime.</p>
