Unfortunately, most analysts believe current indicators provide inadequate measures of key governance processes. The aim of the World Governance Assessment (WGA) is, first, to generate new systematic and meaningful data that will enhance understanding of how governance makes a difference to the way a country develops. The pilot study generated substantive findings for 16 countries representing 51% of the world’s population.</p>
