Précis of 100 Words or Less:	This study explores the linkages between trade policy, corruption, and environmental policy. We begin by presenting a theoretical model that produces several testable predictions, including: i) the effect of trade liberalization on the stringency of environmental policy depends on the level of corruption; and ii) corruption reduces environmental policy stringency. Using panel data from a mix of developed and developing countries from 1982-1992, we find evidence that supports these conjectures. We view these results as representing an attempt at understanding the myriad of complex relationships that exist in an open economy.
