Précis of 100 Words or Less:	I analyze variation across the postcommunist world in business-state relations, including the degree of corruption. A series of models is developed to explore the argument that state officials will be more inclined to provide a supportive business environment (including protection from rent-seeking bureaucrats) for firms which are especially <i>taxable</i> . Thus, for example, the failure of politicians in many postcommunist states to foster the development of small enterprises is linked to the ease with which such firms avoid tax obligations to the state. Empirical support for the various models is provided by analysis of the BEEPS survey of firms in 25 postcommunist states.
