Précis of 100 Words or Less:	<p>In this Ph.D dissertation, the implementation of a 1999 World Bank anti-corruption program is evaluated, from a 'realist' perspective. First, it is assessed to what extent the seven participant African countries translated the program's contents into substantive national anti-corruption reforms. These different levels of implementation are then explained from the countries' political-administrative systems (e.g. degrees of political or civil liberties), as well as from the processes of decision-making, internal to each country. These processes regard, for example, the relative reform preferences of powerful decision-makers.</p> <p>The final part of the book focuses upon the individual, who participated in the learning courses of the World Bank's program. Through two comparative case studies of Kenya and Tanzania, it is assessed how much influence these 'change agents' exerted on their country's anti-corruption reforms.</p>
