A critic inventory of actions already carried out by the successive governments: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - insufficiency of political good-will clearly affirmed by controlling (executive powers and legislature) and supported by the sincere actions; - inexistence of a permanent system of update of the repressive texts; - bad training of the agents of control and the judges in charge of the continuations as regards financial delinquency;

What it is advisable to do for better fighting against corruption:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - a better policy of information and sensitizing in order to highlight the negative impact of corruption on the development and on the quality of the life, in particular for that the poor people; - introducing a system of permanent control and update of the repressive legal arsenal, so that all new forms of fraud are immediately identified and legally repressed; - planning the signature of bilateral agreements or multilateral of legal co-operation finally to facilitate the continuations and the investigations as regards transnational delinquency.
